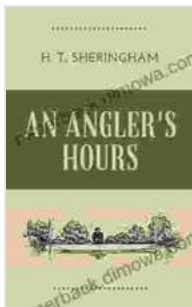

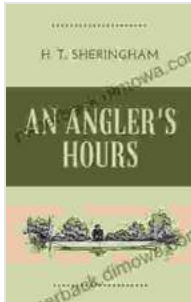
About the Author

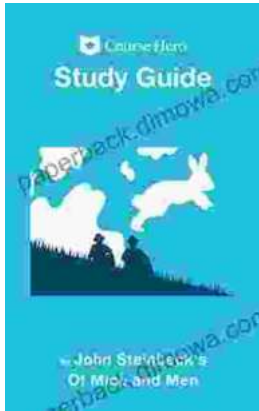
